

President Obama Announces Estate Tax Deal With Republicans

A few days after Sen. Max Baucus introduced legislation that would set the federal estate tax personal exemption amount at \$3.5 million, President Obama announced a deal with Republicans that sets the exemption amount at \$5 million. This would allow a married couple with the proper estate planning to pass \$10 million to their heirs tax free. The deal would also set the estate tax rate at 35%. Although an agreement has been announced, no legislation has been introduced or passed.

The agreement on estate taxes is temporary, it sets the \$5 million exemption amount and 35% tax rate for the next two years. The estate tax would revert to a \$1 million exemption and 55% rate in 2013 without further legislation. Therefore, this deal unfortunately fails to provide the long term certainty that planners have been seeking.

In addition to providing a two-year estate tax fix, the agreement between President Obama and Republicans also extends the Bush era income tax cuts for two years, extends the 15% top rate on capital gains and dividends for two years, and extends unemployment benefits for 13 weeks.
